75-80% of pets over the age of 3 have **dental disease**. Dogs and cats should *not* have a strong odor to their breath. Brushing your pet's teeth is a great way to help prevent dental disease. If you are unable to brush your pet's teeth daily, consider having regular dental cleanings performed as recommended by your pet's Doctor.

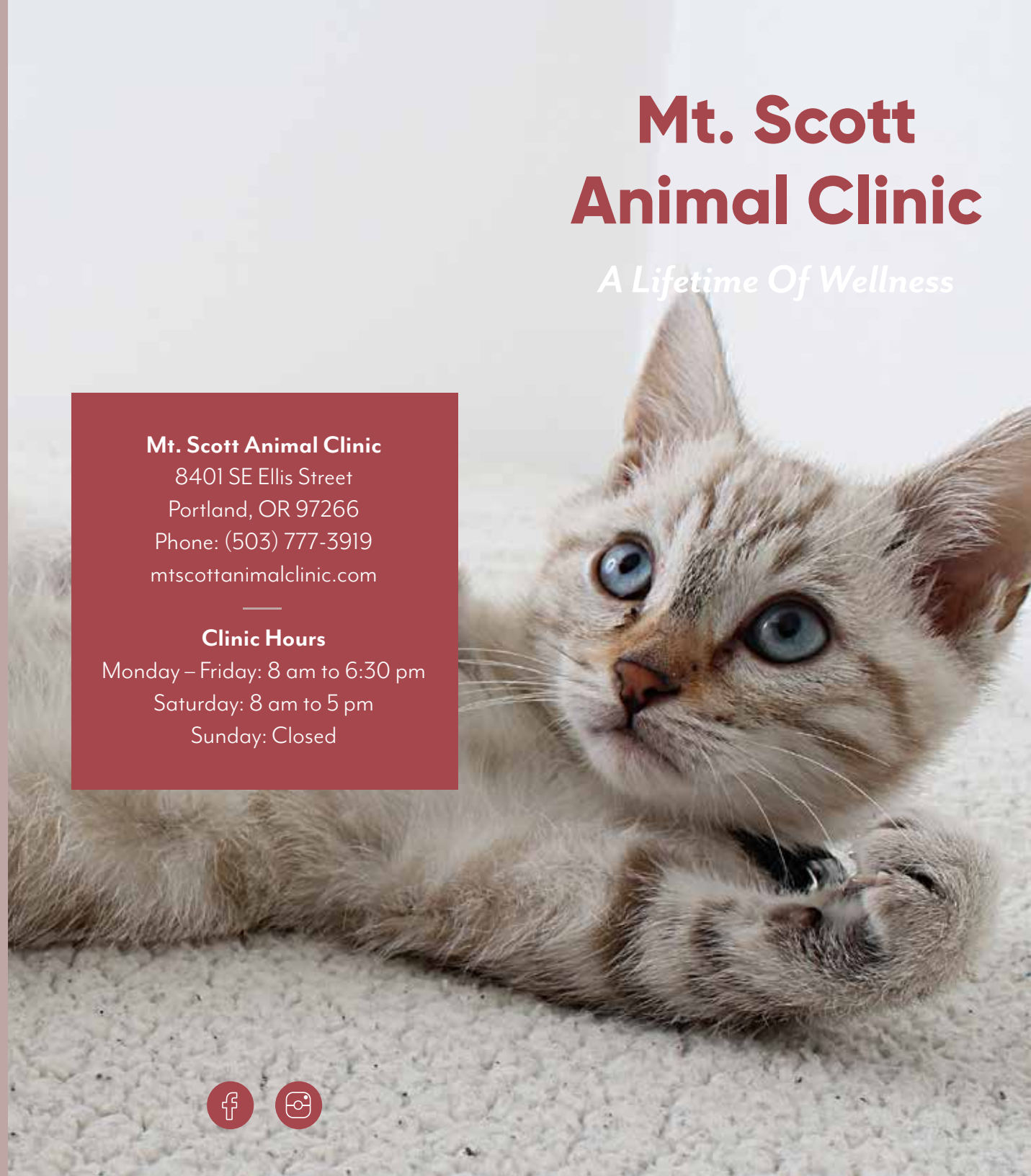

## FELINE WELLNESS

### 6-10 WEEKS | FIRST VISIT

- Wellness Exam
- Discuss FELV/FIV Disease
- Fecal Screening
- 1st Deworming after fecal is collected
- Flea and Heartworm Prevention
- 1st FVR/CP Vaccine
- Discuss Pet Insurance Benefits

### 9-12 WEEKS | SECOND VISIT

- Progress Exam
- FELV/FIV Testing
- 2nd FVR/CP Vaccine
- 1st FELV Vaccine
- 2nd Deworming if fecal test performed
- Monthly Flea and Heartworm prevention

### 12-15 WEEKS | THIRD VISIT

- Progress Exam
- 3rd FVR/CP Vaccine
- 2nd FELV Vaccine (1 year)
- Monthly Flea and Heartworm prevention

### 16-19 WEEKS | FOURTH VISIT

- Progress Exam
- 1 yr FVR/CP
- 1 yr Rabies
- Monthly Flea and Heartworm prevention

### 4-6 MONTHS

- Pre-operative blood screening
- Spay/Neuter
- Monthly Flea and Heartworm prevention



## FELINE WELLNESS

### 1-4 YEARS

- Semi-Annual Wellness Exam
- Body Condition Scoring/Nutrition
- Fecal Screening
- FVR/CP 3 yr Vaccine
- Rabies 1 yr Vaccine
- FELV 1 year Vaccine (for first 2 yrs then risk based)
- FELV/FIV Test annually for at risk patients
- Monthly Flea and Heartworm prevention
- Dental Assessment / Cleaning

### 5+ YEARS

- Semi-annual Wellness Exam
- Body Condition Scoring/Nutrition
- Fecal Screening
- 1 yr Rabies Vaccine (PureVax)
- 3 yr FVR/CP Vaccine
- Discuss FELV 1 yr Vaccine (if at risk)
- Monthly Flea and Heartworm prevention
- Dental Assessment/Cleaning
- CBC/Chem/Urine/Thyroid Check

### SENIOR WELLNESS SCREENING

- Blood Screen
- Blood Pressure
- Tonometry
- Fundic Exam
- Survey Radiographs

## ADULT WELLNESS

### WITH PRIOR VACCINES

- Update FELV/FIV combo test if needed
- Follow 1-4 yr and 5+ yr protocol

### WITHOUT PRIOR VACCINES | FIRST VISIT

- Wellness Exam
- Age dependent recommendations above
- Fecal Exam
- FELV/FIV Combo Test
- 1st FVR/CP Vaccine
- 1st FELV Vaccine
- 1 yr Rabies
- Start monthly Flea/Heartworm Prevention
- Discuss Pet Insurance Benefits

### 3-4 WEEKS | SECOND VISIT

- If Vaccines Only
- 1 yr FVR/CP Vaccine
- 1 yr FELV



#### Key

- FELV = Feline Leukemia Virus
- FVR/CP = Feline upper respiratory/calici virus
- FELV/FIV test = Feline Leukemia/Feline Immunodeficiency Virus
